Clothes

You may have seen, on the news, about the importance of ventilation to limit the spread of COVID 19 when indoors. This does mean that, in line with our risk assessment, all our windows and some doors remain open throughout the day. This will be the case throughout Winter (until we are informed otherwise), so please ensure your child wears suitable clothes. They should continue to wear school uniform and PE clothes on PE days, but may need more layers underneath. The heating will stay on, to try to maintain a comfortable temperature. Schools in the local area are seeking guidance on what happens if the temperature drops too low, but at the moment, there has been no answer.

Christmas

The response to the Christmas trail has been over whelming and we are having to adapt it slightly because there are so many houses involved, spread over the whole village—which is quite a distance when you have little legs. Instead of one trail there will be more shorter trails. You could choose to do as many as you like. You could even buy two maps of the same trail and have a competition within the family to finish in the quickest time. The maps will be ready during the last week of term and the trail will take place between 18th December and 1st January—you could do the trail over a series of days. The cost of each map will be £2 and instructions for how to solve the puzzle will be on the map.



We have enough houses for the letters for the Christmas trail now— if you wanted to join in, you could still decorate part of the front of your house, as people will see it as they walk around. Otherwise, please buy a map and join in that way.

Christmas cards can be sent within school to children who are part of the same bubble. They can be posted into a box in the classroom and will be delivered 72 hours later.
