Finally, I am allowed to share our very exciting news!!

We have been awarded a grant to help us reduce our carbon footprint and work will take place on the school building over the summer holidays to enable us to reduce our carbon emissions by **67%**!!

We are part of a pilot scheme and along with only a handful of Lancashire schools, we are the first in the country to move to an air source heating system and full LED lighting, powered by new solar panels.

Not only will it benefit the environment, we are hoping that it will reduce our bills too!

I am hoping that we will be able to form an eco-group in September with the children, so that we can look at other ways to help the environment. They will also learn more about how it all works so that when we are talking to other schools about it, they can be great ambassadors.

It is a very exciting project and one that we can be very proud to be involved in.
