Sports Day
Friday

In order to be able to have spectators at the Sports Day this year, we need to follow strict guidelines. A risk assessment has been written and there are some things that we need to ask of you;

- Only one household bubble per family should attend.
- If you or your child has covid symptoms, please do not come to school. We know that all the children are so enthusiastic about being part of sports day, but if they are ill, they must not be in school.
- All adults should take a lateral flow test prior to attending.
- Please wash your hands or sanitise them before entering the school grounds – sanitiser will be available, however it is recommended that you have and use your own.
- Please bring your own chairs or picnic rug.
- You will need to be more than 2m away from where the children are racing and from other household groups and stay seated at all times.
- Ensure your child knows that they need to stay with their class and not move between you and the class bubble.
- Please note – NO TOILETS WILL BE AVAILABLE BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE SPORTS DAY FOR SPECTATORS (we estimate that it will last for about 1 hour).

We aim to start at 1.15pm and you will be able to take your child home at the end of the event.

SPORTS DAY ARRANGEMENTS MAY BE CHANGED DUE TO THE WEATHER OR IF WE HAVE COVID CASES IN SCHOOL.

We are going GREEN!

Finally, I am allowed to share our very exciting news!!

We have been awarded a grant to help us reduce our carbon footprint and work will take place on the school building over the summer holidays to enable us to reduce our carbon emissions by **67%!!**

We are part of a pilot scheme and along with only a handful of Lancashire schools, we are the first in the country to move to an air source heating system and full LED lighting, powered by new solar panels.

Not only will it benefit the environment, we are hoping that it will reduce our bills too!

I am hoping that we will be able to form an eco-group in September with the children, so that we can look at other ways to help the environment. They will also learn more about how it all works so that when we are talking to other schools about it, they can be great ambassadors.

It is a very exciting project and one that we can be very proud to be involved in.
