Also, many thanks for all the mufti money from last Friday—the total raised from mufti and buying the bands was £103.

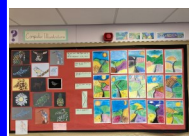
The ladies collecting the shoe boxes were very impressed—thank you for your kind contributions, we sent 20 boxes off.
