## Statutory Assessments

Well done to all our Y6 children who worked so hard last week in their SATs. Y2 have been doing theirs this week, and they have been superstars! Y2 SATs are to aid teacher assessment and have been done in class, in breakout spaces, in small groups or 1:1. We ensured the individual needs of each child were met and have staffed them accordingly.

Children were encouraged to do their best and given the time they need to complete the assessments.

We work incredibly hard not to put the children under pressure during this week and we ask you to do the same. We're not quite finished yet, but they will be by Tuesday.
