



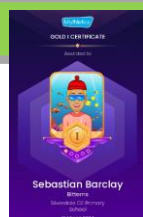

Report cards

Report cards are going home today with your children (yellow paper). If you have any questions about them, please email Miss Sanderson. At the end of each term, teachers have to check and report attainment and progress for each child. This enables us to spot any gaps in children's knowledge and work to fill these. Part of doing this involves the children sitting assessments in maths, reading and GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling). The results of these assessments are used, alongside teacher assessment, to identify the level children are working at and to report to parents. All assessments are delivered in a supportive manner, with children encouraged to do their best to show what they can do. In May, children have to sit SATs (Standard Assessment Tests) and this is one way of gently preparing them for this. There are no formal Y2 SATs this year, however, we will still use papers to help us benchmark our children. Y6 children may do more practice tests to help them prepare when necessary. Miss Jackson is doing this in SATs club on a Thursday.
